Organization Description:

Since 2005, Pat's Place has served as a multidisciplinary hub, bringing together detectives, child protection workers, medical and mental health providers, prosecutors to respond collaboratively to child sexual abuse allegations.

Our mission is to drive resolution of child sexual abuse cases through investigation and collaboration with key partner agencies; provide a safe and compassionate environment that puts the well-being of the child first; break the cycle of abuse through training, education and community outreach. In 2013, we served over 550 children exposed to child sexual abuse, severe neglect, physical abuse and witness to violence.

Position Title: Therapist (Full or Part-Time)
Reports To: Director of Clinical Services

Position Description: The Therapist will provide assessment and therapeutic services for children up to the age of 17 years and their protective caregivers. Flexible schedule with availability at least 2 evenings per week. Full or part-time available.

Responsibilities:

- Conducts thorough initial clinical assessments.
- Develops comprehensive treatment plans.
- Provides individual, family and group therapy.
- Ensures that all documentation related to provision of client services is completed in accordance with policies and procedures.
- Participates in clinical supervision at agreed upon intervals.
- Exhibits enthusiasm, respect, flexibility and a cooperative attitude.
- Create and maintain strong, positive relationships with staff, interns, volunteers, management and community partners.
- Participate in regular staff meetings, multidisciplinary (MDT) meetings, in-service training and other meetings as required.
- Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications

- Master's degree in social work, psychology or counseling.
- 5 years minimum direct clinical experience post master's degree required.
- Bilingual preferred in English and Spanish.
- Knowledge of the impact of trauma on childhood development.
- Direct experience working with children exposed to trauma.
- Licensure from State of North Carolina.



- Training and experience in delivering TF-CBT and other evidence based treatment modalities.
- Demonstrated ability to build collaborative relationships internally and externally and work as part of a team with maturity and professionalism.
- Willingness to commit to the mission and vision of Pat's Place, maintaining the highest standard of professionalism, promoting respect and enthusiasm.
- Unimpeachable ethics.
- Ability to remain flexible in an ever-changing work environment.
